ABOUT THE VINEYARD

This is an approximately 9-acre monopole of the domaine. It is located just below Premier Cru Les Perrières and is a former quarry of Nuits-Saint-Georges, which was utilized by the monks of Citeaux. It was cited by Dr. Lavalley in 1855 when he documented Burgundy wines. His book considers this vineyard one of the best vineyards in the village.

SOILS

Sitting on the stony pink limestone Premeaux, the Clos des Porrets is composed of calcareous scree and soil rich in clay.

WINES

The wines from here express an elegant finesse after only a few years in bottle.
