Winemaker Notes: This single-clone, single-vineyard wine from the Starscape Vineyard in the Russian River Valley is sourced from some of the oldest Pinot Noir vines in all of Sonoma, with these beauties first taking root in 1971. Yielding just one ton of fruit per acre, these vines have provided us with beautiful berries full of complexity, richness, and elegance. Aged for 18 months in French Oak barrels.

Tasting Notes: Elegant and balanced, with an alluring ruby red hue, the 2017 Old Girls opens with inviting aromas of red cherry, cranberry, violets, orange peel and baking spices. The palate mirrors the nose with bright red fruit flavors, soft tannins and a lingering minerality that culminates with a zesty, sophisticated finish.
