With an exceptional terroir and six generations of "savoir-faire," Château Labastide Haute is a family affair. Founded in 1895 and currently managed by Philippe Bernede, the impressive 230 acre estate sits in the Southwest of France with vines that average 35 years of age.

**LOCATION:** Southwest France

**APPELLATION:** AOP Cahors

**AGE OF VINES:** 35 years

**FARMING:** Organic farming practices, reduction of chemical treatments, manual cutting of unwanted shoots, mechanical soil tillage.

**SOIL:** Gravel and clay-limestone silicas

**VARIETY:** 100% Malbec

**ALC.** 12.5%

**TASTING NOTES:** Shiny red with red fruit and spicy notes. Blackberries, black currants, oaky red fruit and licorice notes on the palate. Best paired with red meat, lamb, duck, and strong cheeses
