

MENDING WALL

'17 CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

This wine is all from the Tournahu Vineyard Clone 15 as well as some young vine. Early drinker.

The vintage delivered the perfect amount of sunlit warm days and cool nights that allowed this wine to retain its acidity and mingle with the tannin to deliver a structured and full bodied 100% Cabernet. Peeking through the baked blueberry and ripe plum are just hints of clove oil. On the palate the wine presents a plush, refined texture carrying notes of blueberry, blackberry and currant with an earthy lift. A bit of a show off now, its youthful exuberance will age gracefully for years to come.
